Young Eagles Update

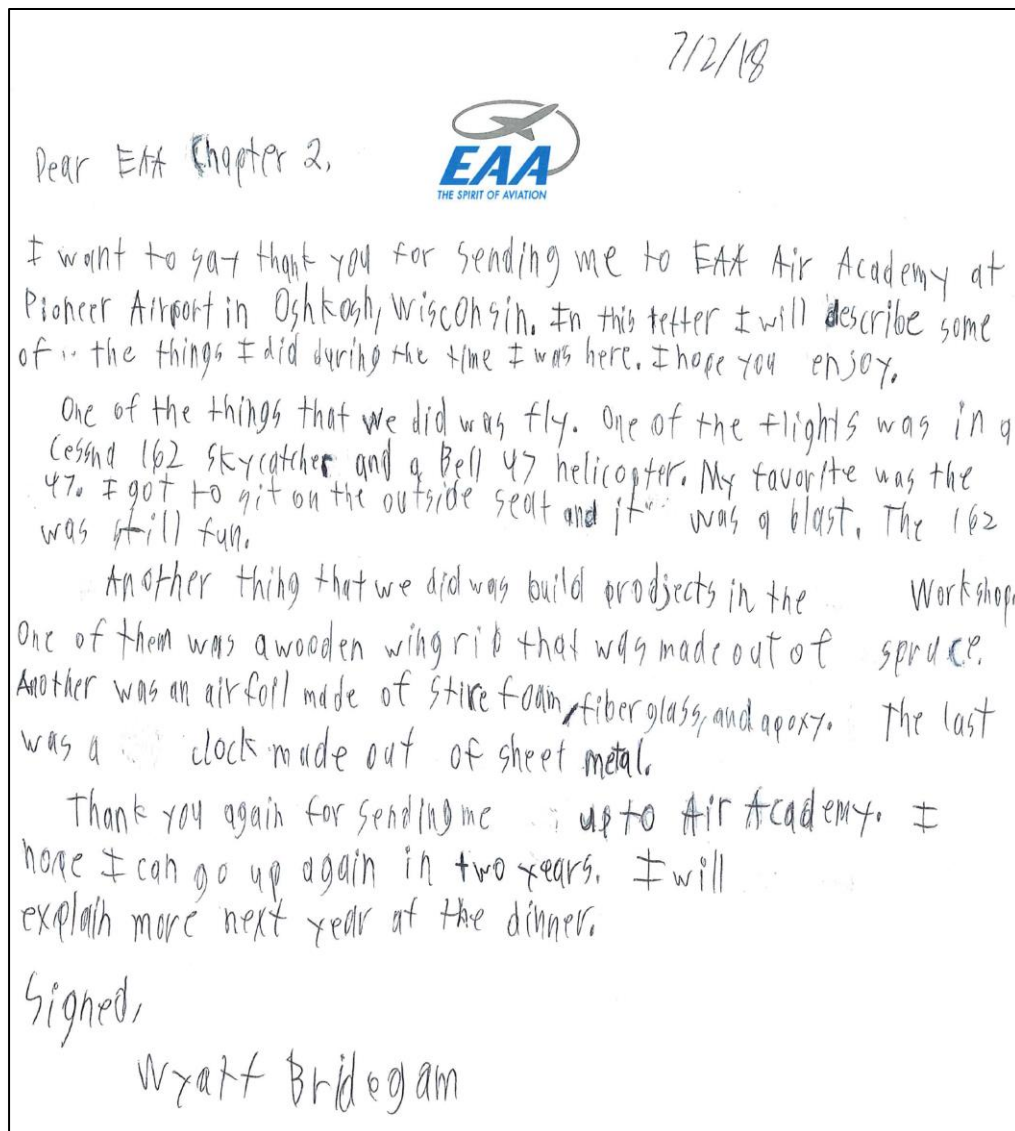
