VMC/IMC Club is an extension to the local EAA & VAA chapters. VAA37 now has a VMC/IMC Coordinator. Dan Leonard has completed the training from EAA. He will be holding scenario based training with group discussion.

According to the EAA website: "The purpose of EAA Visual Meteorological Conditions (VMC) Clubs is to build proficiency when flying under visual flight rule conditions.

"The purpose of EAA Instrument Meteorological Conditions (IMC) Clubs is to promote instrument flying, proficiency, and safety. The intent is to create a community of pilots willing to share information, provide recognition, foster communications, promote safety, and build proficiency in instrument flying."

Pilots who participate in these trainings can receive WINGS credit from the FAA. The first VMC/IMC meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 10 at 7:00 pm.

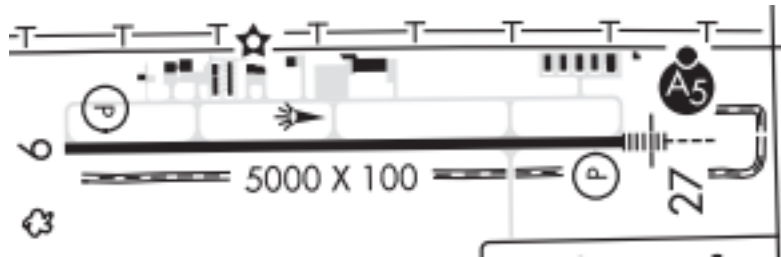
