

EAA Vintage Chapter 37
Scholarship Resolution

Recitals:

- A. EAA Vintage Chapter 37 (hereinafter “the chapter”) has successfully established a once a month pancake breakfast.
- B. The Chapter desires to designate the net proceeds from the breakfast to establish a scholarship for training pilots.
- C. A committee has been formed for the purpose of recommending a policy to establish and administer the scholarship.
- D. The committee has recommended such a policy.
- E. The officers and members have considered such recommendations and adopt same as set forth herein.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved:

- 1. A pilot training scholarship is hereby established.
- 2. The proceeds from the pancake breakfasts shall be accumulated and applied for scholarships, until such time as this scholarship program is terminated and so long as funds are available.
- 3. The officers of the Chapter, or members of the scholarship committee , if directed by the officers, shall award up to \$1000.00 to candidates selected by the officers or committee.
- 4. Candidates shall be selected without regard to race, gender, religious beliefs, age, or country of origin.
- 5. To be eligible for a scholarship, candidates must:
 - A. Be an FAA licensed pilot or student pilot;
 - B. Be a Chapter member;
 - C. Participate in Chapter activities;
 - D. Have demonstrated an interest and intent in obtaining a pilot certificate, advanced rating or endorsement . “Pinch hitter” training shall not qualify for this scholarship.

E. If applicant is a student pilot, the applicant shall have started flight training prior to applying and shall have shown interest in proceeding, as determined by the officers or committee members.

6. The successful applicant shall designate the training facility, and the scholarship funds shall be paid directly to the facility with an agreement with the facility that the funds will be used to purchase "Block time", and that if not used by the applicant, any unused funds shall be returned to the Chapter, as negotiated by Chapter and facility.

7. The successful candidate will be given six (6) months from the time of the award to utilize the funds. If not utilized in six (6) months, all remaining funds shall be returned to the Chapter, as set forth in paragraph six (6).

8. Applications shall be reviewed and scholarships shall be granted as received and as funds are available.
